

**International Linguistic Science and Practice Conference "Methods of Teaching Foreign Languages 2.0: Real vs. Virtual"** was organized by Department of Foreign Languages and Intercultural Communication of Faculty of International Economic Relations of the Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation, Center "Pushkin Institute" of the Faculty of Humanities of the Juraj Dobrila University of Pula, Croatia, Department of Foreign Languages and Translation of Ural Federal University named after the first President of Russia B.N.Yeltsin, Université Grenoble Alpes, France. The conference was held on June 17, 2021 at the Financial University online.
